Predictably, the global coronavirus pandemic had a drastic impact on the number of passengers flying through Northern Ireland's main airports with each month in 2020 seeing a decrease in passengers when compared to the same month in 2019.



The number of total passengers decreased by 73% in 2020 compared to 2019, down from 8.9m to 2.4m.




The number of passengers was highest during January and February with over half a million passengers in each month before national lockdown reduced travel to just over 2,500 and 6,000 passengers in April and May, respectively.



A reduction in the declines were evident over the summer months following the reopening of many tourism businesses in July 2020 although the reductions remained significant.

The following page highlights the total monthly passengers for each NI airport; Belfast International Airport (BIA), George Best Belfast City Airport (BCA) and City of Derry Airport (DCA).



Belfast International Airport continues to have had the highest passenger carryings with 1,747,086 travelers flying in 2020. This is a 72% decrease compared to 2019.



George Best Belfast City Airport saw 542,567 passengers in 2020 – a decline of 78% compared to 2019.



City of Derry Airport saw the smallest decrease in annual passenger numbers with 80,494 passengers in 2020 – down 60% on 2019.



Each of the three airports saw the same general trend throughout 2020 whereby the number of passengers travelling drastically decreased after February as the coronavirus restrictions brought the travel industry to a halt.




Unlike Belfast International Airport and City of Derry Airport, George Best Belfast City Airport did not see the same spike in passenger carryings in July and August. Instead, this airport saw a more gradual increase when restrictions eased.



Before the major impact of the pandemic, City of Derry Airport had shown increases in passenger numbers for January and February 2020 when compared with the same months in 2019.



Total Annual NI Airport Passengers (2010-2020)





This graph shows the annual NI airport passenger numbers from 2010-2020.



The chart highlights that the number of passengers passing through NI three main airports remained relatively steady between 2010-2014 before seeing year on year increases between 2015-2018.



The severe 73% decline in 2020 emphasizes the impact of COVID-19 on the travel industry in NI as annual passenger numbers fell from just below 9 million in 2019 to around 2.3 million in 2020.

Annual NI Airport Passenger Routes (2013-2020)



This graph shows the total number of UK and EU/International passengers coming through NI airports between 2013-2020.

Prior to 2020, UK passenger numbers had been growing stedily between 2015-2019. EU and International travel had been seeing larger growth in the same time period.

The coronavirus pandemic has had a significant impact on all passenger routes in 2020. EU and International passenger numbers (-86%) were worse affected than UK passengers (-69%) likely due to stricter travel restrictions outside of the UK.
