








MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Plot growth over the past 7 days has been higher than predicted at an average of 55.3 kg DM/ha/d. However, growth rates across the GrassCheck farm network have started to fall in most counties.
- Average air temperatures are expected to only reach single figures in the next few weeks, meaning a fall in grass growth rates is expected.
- Soil temps have been added to the map this week, as these will have a greater impact on grass growth in the coming weeks as conditions cool.
- Rotations should now be lengthening to around 35 days, and AFCs building. The current AFC on GrassCheck farms is 2446 kg DM/ha.
