









MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Growth on the GrassCheck plots is 45.9 kg DM/ha/d this week, 10 kg above the long-term average of 35.7 kg for late September. Growth on GrassCheck farms is similar, at an average of 45.2 kg overall.
- Soil temperatures are still >10 °C and should support reasonable grass growth in the coming days, although wetter and cooler weather is expected next week, which is likely to impact growth rates.
- Grass DM has been consistent over the past few weeks at around 15%, and the average ME this week is 11.8 MJ/kg DM, highlighting the value of autumn grazing. This could support an ADG of >1kg and an M+ of 12.6 kg.
