








MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Grass samples taken last week on GrassCheck farms recorded an average DM of 15.9%, but samples from the GrassCheck plots cut this Monday had a DM value of just 12.7% after the heavy rain over this weekend.
- With ground conditions again very wet in many areas, using different tracks and gateways, along with back-fencing paddocks or on-off grazing can minimise any soil damage. Feeding additional forage or concentrates may help to meet intake demands where low DMs prove problematic.
- September yields from the GrassCheck plots averaged 1.41 t DM/ha, slightly above the 1.25 t long-term average.
