



## **MANAGEMENT NOTES:**

- With more typical spring weather now in the long-term weather forecasts, grass growth rates should improve significantly in the next two weeks. But cold nights expected this week are expected to keep growth rates low for the next 7 days.
- During the current public health emergency AFBI's forage analysis labs are temporarily closed and grass quality data unavailable. Plot DM values averaged 23.6% this week, with historic seasonal data presented for other parameters.
- With improved ground conditions for grazing, target your post grazing residuals to set-up swards for good quality regrowth aiming for 1600-1800 kg DM/ha with dairy cows and 1400-1600 kg DM/ha with other cattle/sheep.
