









Week Beginning 23rd August 2021





- With the favourable weather conditions, grass growth rates are continuing to exceed the seasonal average. Forecasting models are predicting this trend to continue for at least another week.
- Continue to measure grass at least weekly. Growth needs to be higher than demand to build covers for the remainder of the grazing season.
- Take advantage of the good ground conditions to achieve target residuals of 1500kg DM/ha. Paddocks which are stemmy should be topped or cleaned out with lower priority stock such as dry cows.
- Continue to follow grazings with N according to your fertiliser plan.
