


## Week Beginning 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023



**MANAGEMENT NOTES:** 

• Grass growth is soaring across the province and it is forecast to remain at the top end of the grass growth curve for at least the next fortnight.


• Measure the grazing platform 3 times in 2 weeks to keep control of grass.

• Take the opportunity to correct grass quality whilst growth exceeds demand. Challenging conditions in spring led to poor grazing residuals and reduced grass quality as a result. Identifying these areas to be removed as surplus bales is the best option. Grazing at lower covers is another option.

• Aim to enter pre-grazing covers of 2,800 - 3,000 kg DM/ha, every 18 – 21 days, over the next 4 grazing rotations to maximise profit and utilisation.

• Minimise supplement feeding to increase grass demand and utilisation.
