



MANAGEMENT NOTES:

Most areas have received enough rain to revive grass growth and for those who have missed the showers, there is a good amount of rain in the forecast.
Grass growth rates are forecast to meet and exceed the LT av. in the next 7 and 14 days respectively, with increased soil moisture and high soil temps.

- The challenge will be when to remove the extra supplement and when to skip paddocks and remove surplus grass. Measure the grazing platform at least weekly to make the best & most timely decisions in this transition.
- Removing paddocks will help to address some of the poorer quality paddocks with a high stem content as a result of the previous conditions.
- Continue to apply fertiliser again in line with a nutrient management plan.
