









## Week Beginning 21st August 2023





- Grass growth is predicted to remain above the long-term, average for the next few weeks which will help with the building of Autumn covers.
- Existing heavy covers can be poorly utilised and should be strip grazed or earmarked for cutting when conditions allow.
- Aim to have poorly grazed swards cleaned out by the beginning of September to allow for good quality regrowth this can be done by topping or grazing with lower priority stock.
- Catch up on Nitrogen applications in line with your fertiliser plan.
