

The average **NI prime cattle price** was up 23.8p/kg to 397p/kg in February 2022. This was a 6.4 per cent increase from February 2021.



The average **NI cow price** increased by 25.2p/kg in February this year.



Across the regions the **R3 steer price** increased by almost 24p/kg in NI, the equivalent of 36.5p/kg in ROI and just over 31p/kg in GB when compared to the same period last year.



NI **prime cattle throughput** increased by 3,525 head in February 2022 with 30,710 prime cattle processed locally. Cow throughput also increased to 9,066 head, up 22.4 per cent from February 2021. Average carcase weights increased by 0.6kg for prime cattle and held steady at 313.3kg for cows.



Imports for direct slaughter were up 192 head in February 2022 compared to the same period in 2021. Exports for direct slaughter totalled 252 head in February 2022, up 58 head from February 2021.



Number of beef sired cattle on the ground aged 12-30 months in February 2022 was back 3.8 per cent from February 2021 to total 412,177 head. Beef sired cattle numbers decreased by 4.6 per cent with dairy male cattle numbers increasing by almost four per cent.



Calf registrations in February 2022 were back 1,551 head when compared to same period in 2021. Beef sired calf registrations decreased by 1.5 per cent from Febuary 2021 levels while dairy male calf registrations were back 19.7 per cent.
