The average **NI prime cattle price** was up 34.1p/kg to 425.7p/kg in October 2022. This was an 8.7 per cent increase from October 2021.



The average NI cow price increased by 47.2p/kg in October this year.



Across the regions the **R3 steer price** increased by 35p/kg in NI, the equivalent of 46.6p/kg in ROI and 31.7p/kg in GB when compared to the same period last year.



NI prime cattle throughput increased by 2,333 head in October 2022 with 32,582 prime cattle processed locally. Cow throughput increased by 1,683 head, up 17.7 per cent from October 2021. Average carcase weights were back by 6.6kg for prime cattle and were back 2.9kg for cows.



Imports for direct slaughter were up 27 per cent in October 2022 compared to the same period in 2021. Exports for direct slaughter totalled 270 head in October 2022, back 157 head from October 2021.



Number of beef sired cattle on the ground aged 12-30 months in October 2022 was back 1.7 per cent from October 2021 to total 404,918 head. Dairy male cattle numbers decreased 5.2 per cent to total 33,728 head.



Calf registrations in October 2022 were up 1,087 head or 4 per cent when compared to the same period in 2021. Beef sired calf registrations increased by 7.7 per cent from October 2021 levels while dairy male calf registrations were back 10.7 per cent or by 583 head.
