

ANNUAL MINERAL STATEMENT 2017

SUMMARY

Of the 134 quarries contacted, 90 responses were received representing a return rate of 67%. There was a 23% reduction in the number of returns received in 2017 compared to 2016.

NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

- 1. Production figures for rock salt, chalk, dolomite, fireclay and granite have been combined into 'Other' to avoid disclosure of confidential information.
- 2. The people employed inside and outside the pit are directly involved in extraction. Lorry drivers and road teams etc., are excluded. The number of management and administration staff cannot be broken down further.
- 3. 134 quarries were contacted and 90 responses were received. 52 quarries reported that they were active (an additional 30 quarries reported production figures); 3 reported inactive but with existing reserves; 2 exhausted; 1 not trading in the period and 1 inactive due to operator illness.
- 4. Commodity weights have been rounded to the nearest million tonne and selling value are presented as pounds sterling rounded to the nearest million plus 2 decimal places.
