PROGRESS TO DATE

While falls continue to be the top incident reported, work continues to raise awareness of falls prevention across all care settings of the Trust. Decreased compliance with adherence to falls bundle A or B is reported to the Nursing SharePoint when audits completed and reasons for and action to improve recorded. Following this monitoring of compliance continues and is discussed at Safe and Effective Care so that learning that may be spread is shared.

During the period of this report many wards/ Departments have faced workforce and increased nursing dependency challenges as a result of the pandemic. There were also additional ward moves to new layouts. This may have been a contributory factor in the increased number and rate of falls. During this time Lead Nurses and Assistant Directors of Nursing have been asked to increase surveillance within their areas of responsibility.

Work continues to report the learning from falls that result in a moderate or above injury to the Public Health Agency (PHA) and also to support and encourage appropriate spread of learning.

Review of moderate and above falls continues to be supported by the Falls Integrated Pathway Co-ordinator who meets with Lead Nurses and Ward Sisters/Charge Nurses, Head of Services as applicable to review all falls incidents graded as moderate and above harm falls for shared learning. Work is ongoing to ensure that staff reporting incidents on Datix, grade incidents correctly and where learning has been identified this is shared with appropriate staff and departments.





The table below demonstrates the Falls Rate per 1,000 bed days and the rate for falls resulting in harm (moderate, major or catastrophic) which is reported quarterly to the PHA via a SharePoint site.
