IDENTIFICATION OF THE ANNUAL IMPLEMENTATION REPORT

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2. OVERVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OPERATIONAL PROGRAMME (ARTICLE 50(2) AND 111(3)(A) OF REGULATION (EU) NO 1303/2013)

2.1. Key information on the implementation of the operational programme for the year concerned, including on financial instruments, with relation to the financial and indicator data.

Background

- The strategic aim of the ESF Programme 2014-2020 in Northern Ireland is to compact poverty and enhance social inclusion.

The programme is structured around 4 priority axis. They are:

- P1 Access to Employment
- P2 Social Inclusion
- P3 Skills for Growth
- P4 Technical Assistance.
- For priority axis 1 and 2, under the 1st call for applications, 66 operations were successful, of which 61 continued to be operational until completion at 31/03/18.
- The 2nd call became operational on 01/04/18 and runs to 31/03/22, 69 operations were successful. 2 successful operations subsequently ceased operation of services and 2 further projects merged leaving 66 operational.
- The new simplified claims and payment process continues to be used in Call 2. This has had a positive impact in terms of timeliness of vouching claims and reductions in error rates and administrative burden. Feedback from organisations continues to be very positive. Processing times have continued to be significantly lower than Call 1, and the amount of staff dedicated to claims processing has reduced, enabling greater focus on performance.
- Priority 3 of the programme is focused on improving the labour market relevant of education and training schemes, specifically through Apprenticeship Programmes.

Programme Monitoring Committee

- PMC were due to meet on 12/05/2020 but this was not possible because of the pandemic. The papers for the meeting were issued to the members for comment. The Committee were again due to meet in November but again this could not happen and was addressed through written communication. The

Communications Plan for 2021 was approved by the Committee by written procedure.

Managing Authority (MA) Designation and ESIF Database

- The NI European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) Database became operational in 2017. As required by regulation this enabled the ability to submit payment applications directly to the EC. Work required to deliver the remaining reporting and irregularity handling elements was completed over subsequent months before the database was signed off. The ESIF Database Project Board final implementation and exception report was agreed by written procedure and the Project Board was dissolved.
- A Database User Group was established to oversee the operation of the database. It monitors spend, system performance, change requests, enhanced functionality or new requirements.

Programme Expenditure / N+3

- P1 and P2 Call 2 expenditure of E10.270m (E5.135m ESF) was submitted in January 2020 and further expenditure of E17.050m (E8.525m ESF) was submitted in September 2020.
- P1/P2 total expenditure submitted since programme inception is E176.824m. The figure reflects the 18/19 annual accounts deductions as detailed in table 5.
- Total reimbursement received in respect of P1/P2 in 2020 = E12.294m (90% of the claims submitted).
- P3 expenditure of E4.890m (E1.956m EDF) was submitted by September 2020, bringing total expenditure reported to E78.864m since programme inception. This figure reflects the 17/18 and 18/19 annual accounts deductions as detailed in table 5. A total of E1.760m was received from the EU in respect of P3 during 2020.
- P4 expenditure of E379k (E227k ESF) was submitted in 2020,
- By December 2020 cumulative expenditure of E122.759m contributed towards the achievement of the 2020 N+3 target. This exceeded the target of E76.41m and represents a surplus of E46.349m towards the 2021 target.
- P1, 2 and 3 expenditure for the 20/21 financial year has been fully nationalised and will not be included in a future drawdown. Therefore, for Common Output Indicators only participants who commenced from 01/01/20 31/03/20 are counted in this AIR. For Common Result Indicators, participants who started before 01/04/20 and left during 2020 are included. Some adjustments will also be required in 2021.

Modifications of the Operational Programme (OP)

- A modification to the OP was accepted by the EC in December 2017. This modification request was needed because of incorrect assumptions used in setting original targets.
- Further adjustments were required to priority level allocations, to reflect actual activity levels and those predicated following completion of the Call 2 application process. This modification request was underpinned by evidence of changing macro socio-economic conditions.
- To alleviate budget pressures, and taking cognisance of significant variations in FX rates, it was necessary to reset intervention rates for Call 2 projects. Additional national funding was allocated into P3 to offset the reduced ESF allocation. The programme modification was agreed by the EC on 15 November 2018.
- To note, a further programme modification was submitted to the EC on 18 February 2021 in relation to increasing the ESF intervention rate for priority 3 moving from 40% to 60%. No changes to programme targets were proposed. This modification was agreed by the EC on 17 March 2021.

Publicity and Communications

- The following provides a summary of the main actions completed against the 2020 Communications Plan
- Webpage The ESF MA webpage on the DfE website is the main portal for providing information.
- NI Direct ESF Page An ESF page on NI Direct provides citizens with an overview of the programme.
- **Social Media** A number of posts have been made on the Department's Facebook and Twitter accounts.
- Case Studies 19 were uploaded to the website for 2020. A decision has been taken to stop using participants' names and other identifiers so as to protect participants' identities due to the sensitive nature of some of the details that are included in case studies. All case studies that were previously published were removed, anonymised and are in the process of getting republished. Case studies continue to be a fantastic opportunity to highlight positive success stories from the programmes.
- Major Event Due to Covid-19 a face to face major event was not possible this year. In response to reports of some innovative practices being implemented by projects a number of online ESF Support Dissemination and Effective Practice Showcase Events were hosted during September and October. These were attended by staff from the beneficiaries and there were several presentations from ESF and project staff. The speakers discussed the ESF programme, its achievements and challenges and provided information on target achievement during the pandemic. They also explained how they

coped and delivered during Covid-19 and outlined innovative approaches that allowed online learning.
- Note - The December 2020 exchange rate of £1:E1.11804 has been applied throughout.

3.1. Overview of the implementation

One operation ceased due to performance issues.
		Operations have supported 34,504 participants (20,070 unemployed and 14,434 economically inactive). This represents outturn of 72% against the 28,000 for unemployed (CO01) and 90% against the 16,000 for economically inactive (CO03) 2023 targets.
		Investment Priority 8ii - This priority focuses on supporting young people aged 16-24 who are not in employment, education or training. All 13 of the original operations that commenced during 2015 continued to deliver their ESF projects at 31 March 2018. 18 operations commenced on 01 April 2018 and all 18 continue to operate.
		Operations have supported 12,980 participants in 8ii. This represents 87% against the 2023 target (PSO01) of 15,000.
		The MA is pleased to confirm that it has already met the target for economically inactive participants (CO03) and is on schudule to met all the targets for 8i & 8ii in full.
2	Social Inclusion	Investment Priority 9(i)(a) - This IP supports unemployed or economically inactive individuals with a disability. 23 of 24 originally supported ESF operations continued to deliver their projects at 31 March 2018. 24 operations commenced on 01 April 2018 and 22 continue to operate. One operation merged with another. Another operation ceased providing services due to difficulties in recruiting participants.
		Operations have supported 11,466 participants. Delivery of this IP continues to perform well, with the MA able to report 88% progress towards the 2023 target (CO16) of 13,000.

4. SYNTHESIS OF THE EVALUATIONS

Synthesis of the findings of all evaluations of the programme that have become available during the previous financial year, with reference of name and reference period of the evaluation reports used

- In accordance with the ESF programme's evaluation schedule as detailed in Annex A of the evaluation plan (available for download from SFC) which was approved by the Programme Monitoring Committee (PMC), formal evaluations of selected investment priorities were due to commence in 2019.
- The Managing Authority undertook a phase 1 evaluation report during 2018/19. The main conclusion was that 'across Call 1 targets and objectives have been met, and there is significant progress being made in relation to achieving call 2 targets.'
- Work on the phase 2 evaluation commenced in late 2019 and a contract was awarded to a supplier to undertake the work.
- Work on this was adversely impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. Consultations with beneficiary organisations and participants were unable to be undertaken during the initial lockdown period.
- Work recommenced during the summer and participant survey and consultations were subsequently undertaken.
- The report was approved by PMC and uploaded to SFC in January 2021.
- The main findings were:
- 1) The programme has been delivered consistently against aims and objectives.
- 2) In terms of management and governance, it is considered effective and has received praise from beneficiaries. The MA have demonstrated pragmatism, fairness and collaboration in their approach.
- 3) For P1 and P2 beneficiaries were selected via a 'Call' process that improved considerably between Call 1 and Call 2. The process under Call 2 is regarded as both effective and efficient.
- 4) Project targets are being met or surpassed, and financial performance is aligned with expectations.
- The main recommendations were:
- 1) Evolution, not revolution.

3) Real time evaluation.
4) Maintain a relationship building approach.
5) Remove level 1 cap
6) Raise the Apprenticeships targeted age.

8) Recognition of 'soft skills' accomplishments and broader 'hard outcomes'

2) Match funding matching service.

7) Equal status with mandated programmes.

(a) Issues which affect the performance of the programme and the measures taken

Covid 19

P1, 2 and 3 expenditure for the 2020/2021 financial year (April 2020 - March 2021) has been fully nationalised and will not be included in any future drawdowns. This resulted in participants who commenced in the 2020/2021 financial year not being counted towards the 2020 AIR as expenditure for those starting between April and December 2020 will not be included within a drawdown over the corresponding period. Therefore, for Common Output Indicators, in this AIR only, participants who commenced from 1 January 2020 - 31 March 2020 are counted. For Common Results Indicators, participants who started before 1 April 2020 and left during 2020 are included.

Indicator Verification Checks

For P1 and 2, verification work on Call 1 and April 2018 - March 2020 for Call 2 data has been finalised. Checks have been enhanced to include verification of data against another independent database that exists within DfE and contains comprehensive data for anyone that has been through the NI school system, those engaged on training programmes or have accessed the Social Security System. Improved guidance has been provided to beneficiaries and, as a result, the significant amount of data that could not be reported, was subject to these enhanced checks.

Call 1 data was found to have an error rate of 27.85% therefore only 72.15% of data was reported. For Call 2 data from 1 April 2018 - 31 December 2019 96% of data was reported as the error rate was only found to be 4%. For 2019 the error rate was 0% therefore 100% of data was reported. For 1 January 2020 - 31 March 2020 the error rate was 0% therefore 100% of data was reported. The increase in the reporting rate is due to the factors listed above.

For P3 verification work has been completed for AppsNI up until March 2020 against the system mentioned above. The error rate for P3 is consistently 0%.

We can confirm that the underreporting rate for the entire programme from 1 April 2015 - 31 March 2020 is 11.02% which is reduced from 11.75% last year. It is anticipated the underreporting rate will continue to progressively fall until the programme end.

Long Term Result Indicators

Results for LTRIs were reported in the 2018 AIR and will be reported again in the 2023 AIR.

Audit Authority Report

Following a report by DfEs Audit Authority a number of figures that were reported in the 2019 AIR have been amended. These relate to the figures for 2019 for 8i and 9i. They are 8i economically inactive (Male) -1, unemployed (male) +1 and inactive not in education or training (male) -1. 9i unemployed (female) -1, economically inactive (female) +1, inactive not in education or training (female) +1. 9i unemployed (female) -1, economically inactive (female) +1, long term unemployed (female) -1 and inactive not in education or training (female) +1. These figures have all been updated in the 2020 AIR.

Prisoners

Prior to the 2020 AIR all prisoners were counted in the figures. During 2020 an ESF memo (17/20) was issued refining the prisoner eligibility criteria. It stated that sentenced prisoners with more than 3 years remaining until their release are not eligible. Those prisoners with more than 3 years remaining until they are due to be released and who started in 2018 and 2019 were reported in the 2018 and 2019 figures have been retrospectively removed. The following amendments have been made:

2018 (all male) 8i - inactive -18, inactive (not in education or training) -18, below 25 -3, primary and lower secondary education -4, with upper secondary education -17, with tertiary education -2, other disadvantaged -6, grand total -18, participants in education or training upon leaving -4, participants in education or training upon leaving (inactive) -4, participants gained a qualification -3, disadvantaged participants engaged in job searching, education / training, gaining a qualification, or in employment -2.

2019 (all male) 8i - participants in education or training upon leaving -14, participants in education or training upon leaving (inactive) -14, participants gained a qualification -14, disadvantaged participants engaged in job searching, education / training, gaining a qualification or in employment -10.

2018 (all male) 8ii - inactive -9, inactive (not in education or training) -9, below 25 - 9, primary or lower secondary education -7, with upper secondary education -2, migrants -1, other disadvantaged -6, grand total -9, participants in education or training upon leaving -1, participants in education or training upon leaving (inactive) -1, disadvantaged participants engaged in job searching, education / training, gaining a qualification or in employment -1.

2019 (all male) 8ii - inactive -1, inactive (not in education or training) -1, below 25 -1, primary and lower secondary education -1, other disadvantaged -1, grand total -1, in education or training -3, in education or training (inactive) -3, in employment -1, in employment (inactive) -1, disadvantaged participants engaged in job searching, education / training, gaining a qualification or in employment -1.

The total number of participants removed comes to 28.

(b) An assessment of whether progress made towards targets is sufficient to ensure their fulfilment, indicating any remedial actions taken or planned, where appropriate.

Priority 1

IP 8(i) and 8(ii) has supported 27,245 unemployed participants which represent 97% of the 2023 performance target (28,000). A further 20,239 inactive participants have been supported, which constitutes 126% progress against the 2023 target (16,000).

5,954 unemployed participants in 8(i) have progressed into employment, well in excess of the target value for 2023 target of 3,850. 3,263 inactive participants in 8(i) have been moved into employment, above the 2023 target of 2,200. A further 2,605 inactive participants have entered education or training which is above the 2023 target of 2,200.

For IP 8(ii) 12,980 participants received support representing 87% of the 2023 target figure (15,000) 2,283 participants have progressed into employment, against a target of 1,800 and 5,351 have entered education or training against a 2023 target of 5,250.

Priority 2

P2 focuses on social inclusion, and comprises of IP 9(i) which includes two sub-priorities, 9i(a) which is for participants with disabilities and 9i(b) NEET participants within families receiving CFSP. These sub-priorities are reported under the same IP however a brief analysis of each is detailed here.

Under 9(i)(a) a total of 11,466 participants received ESF support, representing progress of 88% against the programme's final target of 13,000. 1,247 have progressed into employment against a programme target of 1,300 by 2023. A further 3,236 participants have entered education or training against the target for 2023 of 1,950.

For IP 9(i)(b) the intervention has supported 4,605 participants which constitutes 91% progress towards the 2023 target for the indicator (5,040). 737 participants have progressed into employment against a 2023 target of 505 whilst 1,455 have progressed into education or training against the 2023 target of 1,010.

Priority 3

Indicators are extremely positive. 10,546 participants have achieved a level 2 qualification and 8,929 achieved a level 3 qualification.

It should be noted that the figures relating to the ApprenticeshipsNI programme included within the AIR are management information and not official statistics. They have not undergone the formal process that data must pass to achieve this label and are subject to change.

- The management information is being published in order to meet ESF requirements and to allow timely monitoring of progress of the programmes against targets.
- The data contained within the AIR cannot be reconciled with the Official Statistics for the following reasons:
- i The AIR reports only on eligible ESF funded participants whereas the Official Statistics contain data relating to participants enrolled on the programmes who are not eligible for ESF funding.
- ii The AIR reports progress on a calendar year. The Official Statistics are produced on an academic year and, as such, do not align with ESF reporting requirements.
- iii The topics covered in the Official Statistics publications do not cover all of the areas required to report on progress against the specific ESF indicators.

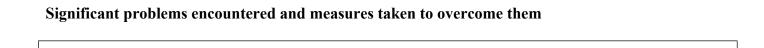
