IDENTIFICATION OF THE ANNUAL IMPLEMENTATION REPORT

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2. OVERVIEW OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OPERATIONAL PROGRAMME (ARTICLE 50(2) AND 111(3)(A) OF REGULATION (EU) NO 1303/2013)

2.1. Key information on the implementation of the operational programme for the year concerned, including on financial instruments, with relation to the financial and indicator data.

Background

The strategic aim of the ESF Programme 2014-2020 in Northern Ireland is to combat poverty and enhance social inclusion.

The programme is structured around 4 priority axes. They are:

- P1 Access to Employment
- P2 Social Inclusion
- P3 Skills for Growth
- P4 Technical Assistance

For priority axis 1 and 2, under the 1st call for applications, 66 operations were successful of which 61 continued to be operational until completion at 31/03/18.

The 2nd call became operational on 01/04/18 and ran to 31/03/22 with 69 operations being successful. 2 operations subsequently ceased operation of services and 2 further projects merged leaving 66 operational.

A 3rd call commenced on 01/04/22 and ran until 31/03/23. 65 projects were successful and continued to the end of the programme.

Programme Monitoring Committee (PMC)

Regular meetings of the Committee were suspended due to the Covid-19 regulations, so a written update was provided to the Committee on 06/05/22. The first in person meeting after the pandemic took place on 22/11/22. The Communications Plan for 2023 was approved at this meeting.

Managing Authority (MA) Designation and ESIF Database

The NI European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) Database became operational in 2017. As required by regulation this enabled the ability to submit payment applications directly to the EC.

Work required to deliver the remaining reporting and irregularity handling elements was completed over subsequent months before the database was signed off. The ESIF Database Project Board final implementation and exception report was agreed by written procedure and the Project Board was dissolved.

A Database User Group was established to oversee the operation of the database. It monitors spend, system performance, change requests, enhanced functionality and new requirements.

Programme Expenditure / N+3

In consultation with the EC, it was determined that due to the effects of the Covid Pandemic on projects and beneficiaries, expenditure would be nationalised for the 20/21 financial year. Therefore, expenditure relating to Priorities 1, 2 and 3 has been fully nationalised for this period. It was later decided that expenditure for March 2020 would also be nationalised for P1&2.

Due to the nationalisation, Priority 1 & 2 participants who commenced between 1 March 2020 and 31 March 2021 were not reported in the 2020 or 2021 AIRs.

P3 participants who commenced between 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2021 were not reported but can be reported in future AIRs if ESF expenditure was incurred for them from 1 April 2021 onwards. The 2020 figures were updated in the 2021 AIR to reflect his. No more starters from the nationalised period have been added to this AIR.

The Apprenticeships 2021 programme commenced in September 2021 but expenditure will only be drawn down from the EC for participants who either (i) started on or after 01/04/22 or (ii) started between September 2021 and March 2022 and for whom expenditure was incurred on or after April 2022. As a result, Apps21 participants were not counted in the 2021 AIR. The 2021 figures will be amended in this AIR to add in those Apps21 participants who have had expenditure on or after 01/04/22.

P1 and P2 Call 2 expenditure of €22.576m (€11.288m ESF) was submitted by May 2022 and further expenditure of €10.560m (€5.280m ESF) was submitted in November 2022 with annual accounts deductions of £97.759k, bringing total expenditure reported to €209.690 (€104.845m ESF). This figure reflects the 17/18, 18/19, 19/20 and 20/21 annual accounts deductions as detailed in table 5.

P3 expenditure of €24.529m (€14.717m ESF) was submitted by May 2022 and further expenditure of €8.934m (€5.361m ESF) was submitted in November 2022, bringing total expenditure reported to €112.322m (€51.631m ESF) since programme inception. This figure reflects the 17/18, 18/19, 19/20 and 2021 annual accounts deductions as detailed in table 5.

P4 expenditure of \in 1.460m (\in 876.181k ESF) was submitted to the EC in 2022. P4 cumulative expenditure reported since programme inception is \in 6.962m (\in 4.177m ESF).

By December 2022 cumulative expenditure in P1, P2, P3 and P4 of E160.654m contributed towards the achievement of the 2022 N+3 target. This exceeded the target of €123.011m and represents a

surplus of €37.643m towards the 2022 target.

Modifications of the Operations Programme (OP)

A modification to the OP was accepted by the EC in December 2017. This modification request was needed because of incorrect assumptions used in setting original targets.

Further adjustments were required to priority level allocations, to reflect actual activity levels and those predicated following completion of the Call 2 application process. This modification request was underpinned by evidence of changing macro socio-economic conditions.

To alleviate budget pressures, and taking cognisance of significant variations in FX rates, it was necessary to reset intervention rates for Call 2 projects. Additional national funding was allocated into P3 to offset the reduced ESF allocation. The programme modification was agreed by the EC on 15/11/18.

To note, a further programme modification was submitted to the EC on 18 February 2021 in relation to increasing the ESF intervention rate for Priority 3 moving from 40% to 60%. No changes to programme targets were proposed. This modification was agreed by the EC on 17/03/21.

A fourth modification of the OP to reallocate funding between Priorities to reflect changing demand aligned with the post-Covid socio-economic climate was submitted to the EC in May 2022. This modification was formally adopted by the EC and implemented in July 2022.

Publicity and Communications

The following provides a summary of the main actions completed against the 2022 Communications Plan.

Webpage - The ESF MA webpage on the DfE website is the main portal for providing information.

NI Direct ESF Page - AN ESF page on NI Direct provides citizens with an overview of the programme.

Social Media - Posts have been made on the Department's Facebook and Twitter accounts.

Case Studies - 19 were uploaded to the website for 2022. Case studies continue to be a fantastic opportunity to highlight positive success stores from the programmes.

Major Event - The Education and Training Authority (ETI) held an event for projects on 12/05/22 celebrating achievements during Call 2. PDB also held a People and Skills Celebration event on 27/10/22 in the Stormont Hotel which provided an excellent opportunity to outline the positive impact of the ESF programme. Representatives from all projects were invited and the Minister for the Economy attended. Gregorio DeCastro from the European Commission provided a video which was

presented during the plenary session. This acknowledged the success of the NI ESF Programme and recognised the excellent partnership that had been developed over the years of participation.

Exchange Rate

The December 22 exchange rate of £1:€1.15985 has been applied throughout.

		The TA allocation of €13.842m was revised to €9.259 following modification 4 which was formally adopted by the EC in July 2022. A total of €11.699 had been reported as allocated by end 2022 to meet administration cost requirements. Work has been ongoing to reduce allocations to €9.045 (as at the Dec 22 FX rate) and will be updated on SFC as part of the July 23 return. There are no targets associated with this Priority. However, a measure of success is the error rates calculated based on the audits undertaken on 2020- 2021 expenditure that will be reported in 2022 – the error rate was 0%.

4. SYNTHESIS OF THE EVALUATIONS

Synthesis of the findings of all evaluations of the programme that have become available during the previous financial year, with reference of name and reference period of the evaluation reports used

In accordance with the ESF programme's evaluation schedule as detailed in Annex A of the evaluation plan (available for download from SFC) which was approved by the Programme Monitoring Committee (PMC), formal evaluations of selected investment priorities were due to commence in 2019.

The Managing Authority undertook a phase 1 evaluation report during 2018/19. The main conclusion was that 'across Call 1 targets and objectives have been met, and there is significant progress being made in relation to achieving call 2 targets'.

Work on the phase 2 evaluation commenced in late 2019 and a contract awarded to a supplier to undertake the work.

Work on this was adversely impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. Consultations with beneficiary organisations and participants were unable to be undertaken during the initial lockdown period.

Work recommenced during the summer of 2020 and participant survey and consultations were subsequently undertaken.

The report was approved by PMC and uploaded to SFC in January 2021.

The main findings were:

- 1) The programme has been delivered consistently against aims and objectives;
- 2) In terms of management and governance, it is considered effective and has received praise from beneficiaries. The MA have demonstrated pragmatism, fairness and collaboration in their approach.
- 3) For P1 and P2 beneficiaries were selected via a 'Call' process that improved considerably between Call 1 and Call 2. The process under Call 2 is regarded as both effective and efficient.
- 4) Project targets are being met or surpassed and financial performance is aligned with expectations.

The main recommendations were:

1) Evolution, not revolution,

2) Match funding matching service.
3) Real time evaluation.

- 4) Maintain a relationship building approach.
- 5) Remove level 1 cap.
- 6) Raise the Apprenticeships targeted age.
- 7) Equal status with mandated programmes.
- 8) Recognition of 'soft skills' accomplishments and broader 'hard outcomes'.

(a) Issues which affect the performance of the programme and the measures taken

Covid 19

P1 and 2 expenditure for the period March 2020 - March 2021 and P3 expenditure for the 2020 / 2021 financial year (April 2020 - March 2021) was fully nationalised and will not be included in any future drawdowns. This resulted in participants who commenced during these periods not being counted towards the 2020 and 2021 AIRs as expenditure for these periods will not be included within a drawdown over the corresponding period. Therefore, for Common Output Indicators participants who commenced between the dates mentioned above are excluded. For Common Results Indicators, participants who left at any time are included with the expection of those who started in the excluded periods mentioned above.

P3 participants who commenced between 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2021 who are still on the programme and have claimed expenditure after 1 April 2021 can be counted because expenditure can be attributed to them. Therefore the 2020 figures were amended in the 2021 AIR to include those participants who started in these years but have claimed expenditure after 1 April 2021. No additional starts were added to this AIR for that period.

Apps21

The Apps21 programme commenced in September 2021 but no expenditure was attributed to participants until 1 April 2022. Therefore participants who started in 2021 were not counted in last years AIR. The 2021 figures have been amended in this AIR to include those who started in 2021 and who have had expenditure after 1 April 2022. Also any participants who started between 1 January 2022 – 31 March 2022 will have only been included if they have had expenditure after 1 April 2022.

Indicator Verification Checks

For P1 and 2, verification work on Call 1, Call 2 and April – December of Call 3 has been finalised. Checks have been enhanced to include verification of data against another independent database that exists within DfE which contains comprehensive data for anyone that has been through the NI school system, those engaged on training programmes or have accessed the Social Security System. Improved guidance has been provided to beneficiaries and, as a result, the significant amount of data that could not be reported, was subject to these enhanced checks.

Call 1 data was found to have an error rate of 27.85% therefore only 72.15% of data was reported. For Call 2 data from 1 April 2018 - 31 December 2018 96% of data was reported as the error rate was only found to be 4%. For 2019, 2020 and 2021 the error rate was 0% therefore 100% of data was reported. For Call 2 data in 2022 94% of data was reported giving an error rate of 6% - this only applied to 3 months of

2022. For Call 3 data 92% was reported with an error rate of 8% - this applied to 9 months from April – December 2022.

For P3 verification work has been completed for AppsNI up until July 2022 against a DfE system and participant's signed training plans. The error rate for P3 is normally 0% however for a small number of the 2020 participants who were added into the 2021 AIR there was a small error rate applied of 2.33%. For the Apps21 participants who started in 2021 but were not counted until this AIR 93% were reported which gave an error rate of 7%. Verification work for the remainder of 2022 has been delayed due to the introduction of a new IT system which is currently being tested to ensure it fully meets required specifications. Verification work will be done as soon as possible and the figures will be reported in the 2023 AIR.

We can confirm that the underreporting rate for the entire programme from 1 April 2015 - 31 December 2022 is 13% which is increased from 9.02% last year. This is due to the extra verification work that has been done and the removal of some participants from previous years.

Long Term Result Indicators

Results for LTRIs were reported in the 2018 AIR and will be reported again in the 2023 AIR. It has been agreed to report actual figures in the 2023 AIR to cover the period 01/01/2019 - 31/03/23 instead of using a representative sample as this will provide more accurate results.

Audit Authority Report

Following a report by DfE's Audit Authority (AA) a number of figures that were reported in the 2021 AIR have been amended. These related to 1 project which was audited by the AA and it was found that some COI and CRIs were reported wrongly in the 2021 AIR and should be changed. These were admin errors by the project. These figures have all been updated in the 2022 AIR. The AA audited a sample of projects from each investment priority and these were the other issues that they found with the data.

Data Issues

Issues with the data for one P1&P2 project have been discovered and it was therefore decided to remove a percentage of their participants for 2018 / 2019 / 2020 from this year's AIR. These changes have been made in this AIR.

Some participants were duplicated on both ESF projects and Peace projects. Whilst participants were being supported on different days/times (therefore no duplicate in terms of costs paid), they were technically enrolled on both the Peace Programme and ESF at the same time which is not permitted. As such, their performance data is excluded from the AIR.

These participants have been removed and amendments made to the figures in this AIR.

(b) An assessment of whether progress made towards targets is sufficient to ensure their fulfilment, indicating any remedial actions taken or planned, where appropriate.

Priority 1

IP 8(i) and 8(ii) has supported 37,223 unemployed participants which represents 133% of the 2023 performance target (28,000). A further 27,422 inactive participants have been supported, which constitutes 171% progress against the 2023 target (16,000).

8,329 unemployed participants in 8(i) have progressed into employment, well in excess of the target value for 2023 of 3,850 (216%). 4,191 inactive participants in 8(i) have been moved into employment, above the 2023 target of 2,200 (191%). A further 3,779 inactive participants have entered education or training which is above the 2023 target of 2,200 (172%).

For IP 8(ii) 18,495 participants received support representing 123% of the 2023 target figure (15,000). 3,222 participants have progressed into employment, against a target of 1,800 (179%) and 8,146 have entered education or training against a 2023 target of 5,250 (155%).

Priority 2

P2 focuses on social inclusion, and comprises of IP 9(i) which includes two sub-priorities, 9i(a) which is for participants with disabilities and 9i(b) NEET participants within families receiving CFSP. These sub-priorities are reported under the same IP however a brief analysis of each is detailed here.

Under 9(i)(a)&(b) a total of 16,920 participants with disabilities received ESF support, representing progress of 130% against the programme's final target of 13,000. In 9(i)(a) 2,109 have progressed into employment against a programme target of 1,300 (162%). A further 5,473 participants have entered education or training against the target for 2023 of 1,950 (281%).

For IP 9(i)(b) the intervention has supported 6,618 participants which constitutes 131% progress towards the 2023 target for the indicator (5,040). 1,153 participants have progressed into employment against a 2023 target of 505 (228%) whilst 2,182 have progressed into education or training against the 2023 target of 1,010 (216%).

Priority 3

Indicators are extremely positive. 22,946 participants have gained a qualification. 13,348 (58.3%) participants have achieved a level 2 qualification (target is 56%) and 11,682 (50.9%) achieved a level 3 qualification (target is 53%). Details of the percentages achieved can be found at Apprenticeships NI Bulletin (economy-ni.gov.uk).

It should be noted that the figures relating to the ApprenticeshipsNI programme included within the AIR are management information and not official statistics. They have not undergone the formal process that

data must pass and are therefore subject to change.

- The management information is being published in order to meet ESF requirements and to allow timely monitoring of progress of the programmes against targets.
- The data contained within the AIR cannot be reconciled with the Official Statistics for the following reasons:
- i The AIR reports only on eligible ESF funded participants whereas the Official Statistics contain data relating to participants enrolled on the programmes who are not eligible for ESF funding.
- ii The AIR reports progress on a calendar year. The Official Statistics are produced on an academic year and, as such, do not align with ESF reporting requirements.
- iii The topics covered in the Official Statistics publications do not cover all of the areas required to report on progress against the specific ESF indicators.




