### Key trends



In the w/e 05/04/20 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 357.5c/kg, a decrease of 13.3c/kg from 370.7c/kg in the w/e 08/03/20.



NI moved down to seventh place in the EU league table with the equivalent price of 377.2c/kg, a 11.3c/kg decrease from the 388.6c/kg paid during the w/e 08/03/20. The differential between the R3 heifer price in NI and the EU average widened from 17.9c/kg to 19.7c/kg in the w/e 05/04/20.



GB moved down to fifth position on the league table with an equivalent R3 heifer price of 381.3c/kg, a 12.6c/kg decrease from the 393.9c/kg paid in the w/e 08/03/20. The differential between GB and the EU average slightly widened from 23.2c/kg to 23.8c/kg in the w/e 05/04/20.



In ROI the R3 heifer price was 358.6c/kg in the w/e 05/04/20, a decrease of 16.7c/kg from the w/e 08/03/20. This kept it in ninth position in the league table, 1.1c/kg above the EU average price and 18.6c/kg lower than the same price in NI.



The euro increased to €1= 88.3p in the w/e 05/04/20.
