### Key trends



In the w/e 21/06/20 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 364.8c/kg, an increase of 7.7c/kg from 357.2c/kg in the w/e 24/05/20.



NI moved down to fifth place in the EU league table with the equivalent price of 399.9c/kg. This was a 14.8c/kg increase from the 385.1c/kg paid during the w/e 24/05/20. The differential between the R3 heifer price in NI and the EU average widened from 27.9c/kg to 35.1c/kg in the w/e 21/06/20.



GB moved up to fourth position on the league table with an equivalent R3 heifer price of 406.4c/kg, a 23.7c/kg increase from the 382.8c/kg paid in the w/e 24/05/20. The differential between GB and the EU average widened from 25.6c/kg to 41.6c/kg in the w/e 21/06/20.



In ROI the R3 heifer price was 364.8c/kg in the w/e 21/06/20, a decrease of 0.9c/kg from the w/e 24/05/20. This placed it in eighth position in the league table, reporting an equivalent price to the EU average price and 35.1c/kg lower than the same price in NI.



The euro slightly increased to €1= 89.8p in the w/e 21/06/20.
