### Key trends

 In the w/e 20/09/20 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 365 c/kg, an decrease of 3.9c/kg from 368.9 c/kg in the w/e 23/08/20.

 NI moved down to sixth place in the EU league table with the equivalent price of 396.1c/kg. This was a 16.7c/kg decrease from the 412.9c/kg paid during the w/e 23/08/20. The differential between the R3 heifer price in NI and the EU average narrowed from 43.9c/kg to 31.2c/kg in the w/e 20/09/20.

 GB moved down two positions to fourth place on the league table with an equivalent R3 heifer price of 407.3c/kg, a decrease of 12.1c/kg from the 419.4c/kg paid in the w/e 23/08/20. The differential between GB and the EU average narrowed from 50.5c/kg to 42.4c/kg in the w/e 20/09/20.

 In ROI the R3 heifer price was 364.6c/kg in the w/e 20/09/20, a decrease of 6.9c/kg from the w/e 23/08/20. This placed it in seventh position in the league table, 0.4c/kg below the EU average price and 31.5c/kg lower than the price in NI.

 The euro increased to €1= 91.1p in the w/e 20/09/20.
