

Involvement Strategy monitoring

Overview report - July 2019

In-line with the Involvement strategy monitoring Objective 1, a monitoring process will be implemented at regular points during the programme.

This report provides an overview of the 2nd monitoring round, which was undertaken in June 2019, following the Stocktake event. The survey seeks to determine how involved members feel during the implementation of the Hyponatraemia Implementation Programme and how their involvement is contributing to the overall work.

This report provides a short overview of responses received.

Responses received:


- 96 responses received, which is 46% of total workstream members (n=208).
- At least one representative from each workstreams responded.
- Responses were received from all the stakeholder groupings represented on the workstreams.

Overview of responses:

- Overall members strongly agreed/agreed that:
 - The IHRD implementation programme objectives are clear.
 - They were clear about their role in the programme
 - They have an important contribution to make
 - That information shared as part of the workstream has supported their involvement
 - That the necessary mechanisms have been put into place to support their involvement
 - That they able to make my voice heard in workstream discussions
 - Feedback has been received in relation to the process to date and progress being made.
- Some members were unsure or disagreed that the appropriate mix of people representing different sectors/backgrounds have been engaged in their workstream.

Members responded to a series of questions, the details of which have been shared with the Programme Manager. The Involvement Team picked out the response to question 9 detailed below which is of particular significance in terms of involvement and co-production.

On a scale of 1 to 10, members were asked how effective is the co-production approach to the IHRD implementation programme? (1 being little effect and 10 being very effective).



Narrative commentary:

A number of Workstream members made narrative comments on their involvement in the Hyponatraemia Implementation Programme, which have been themed and include issues around:

- **Competing priorities**
- **Co-production approach**
- **Support for participation**
- **Focus**
- **Managing expectations**
- **Up-dates**
- **Wider concerns**

All the findings will be considered by the Programme Team in relation to potential actions that may be required to support involvement.

The next survey will be undertaken in early 2020.
