

COLUMBIAN THREE YEAR PROGRAME OF WORK

2021-2024

BACKGROUND

The Northern Ireland Policing Board has a legislative requirement to monitor the performance of the Police Service Northern Ireland (PSNI) in complying with the Human Rights Act 1998, and to include an assessment of their performance in the Board's Annual Report. To assist the Board in carrying out this function, the Human Rights Monitoring Framework was reviewed and approved by the Board in July 2021.

The Three Year Programme of Work outlines the focus of the Board's Human Rights monitoring, as well as the work of our Independent Human Rights Advisor over the next three years, quarter by quarter.

These areas are subject to change given the dynamic nature of the Monitoring Framework and it is intended that the Board will review the Programme of Work on a regular basis, at least every six months. Ongoing consultation with wider stakeholders will inform the prioritisation of work areas.
