Introduction

This report presents data on Public Bodies sponsored by the Executive as at 31st March 2017. The report has been prepared using information supplied by the nine Government Departments and the Food Standards Agency (FSA). It does not include Public Bodies operating which are sponsored by the Northern Ireland Office (NIO).

On 8 May 2016 the number of Northern Ireland Executive Departments reduced from twelve to nine. It is therefore not possible to directly compare the Departmental breakdown in this year's report with the breakdown detailed in previous reports.

Public Appointments and Public Bodies

A Public Body is not part of a Government Department, but carries out its functions to a greater or lesser extent at arm's length from central Government. For this reason Executive Agencies are not included in the Public Appointments presented within this report.

Ministers are ultimately accountable to the Assembly for the activities of the Public Bodies sponsored by their departments and in most cases, except, for example, where there is separate statutory provision, Ministers make the appointments to the boards of Public Bodies.

For the purposes of this report, the term 'Public Body' is a general one which includes Non-Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs), Public Corporations and Health and Social Care Bodies / Special Agencies. NDPBs are the most common Public Bodies and there are three main types:

Executive NDPBs – established in statute and carrying out administrative, regulatory and commercial functions. They employ their own staff and are allocated their own budgets.

Advisory NDPBs – provide independent and expert advice to Ministers on particular topics of interest. They do not usually have staff but are supported by staff from their sponsoring department. They do not usually have their own budget, as costs incurred fall within the department's expenditure.

Tribunal NDPBs – have jurisdiction in a specialised field of law. They are usually supported by staff from their sponsoring department and do not have their own budgets.

The overarching principle underpinning the appointment of board members to Public Bodies is that selection should be made on merit, using fair, open and transparent procedures that ensure that the best available candidate is selected and appointed to each post.

The Commissioner for Public Appointments for Northern Ireland (CPANI) regulates the Public Appointment process to ensure that appointments are made on merit and in accordance with the principles set out in the Commissioner's Code of Practice. All Public Bodies and Public Appointments falling within the Commissioner's remit are shown in this Report as 'CPANI Regulated' and all other Public Bodies and Public Appointments are shown as 'Unregulated'. Departments, when making Public Appointments to unregulated bodies, apply the Commissioner's Code of Practice which sets out the principles and procedures to be followed. Non-Departmental Public Bodies

There were **112** Non-Departmental Public Bodies sponsored by the Executive as at 31 March 2017. This figure is made up of **61** Executive NDPBs, **8** Advisory NDPBs, **5** Tribunal NDPBs, **13** Health and Social Care Bodies / Special Agencies, **1** Public Corporation, **22** Other Bodies and **2** Ad-hoc advisory groups. Tables 1 provides a breakdown of the number and type of Public Bodies by department. Table 2 provides a list of all public bodies by type and department.

Departmental Public Appointment Plans and Statistics:

Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs

1. Policy

During the period of this Report the Department sponsored the following four public bodies:-

- Agri-Food and Biosciences Institute (AFBI)
- Agriculture Wages Board for Northern Ireland (AWB)
- Livestock and Meat Commission for Northern Ireland (LMC)
- Northern Ireland Fishery Harbour Authority (NIFHA)

In addition the Department also sponsored two Ad-hoc Advisory Groups – the Agri-Food Strategy Board (AFSB) (sponsored jointly with DETI (Invest NI)) and the TB Strategic Partnership Group (TBSPG). Although membership of these short-term bodies is not regulated by the Commissioner, appointments are made in keeping with the principles of the Commissioner's Code of Practice.

The Department is committed to following the Commissioner's Code of Practice when making appointments to its Public Bodies. It adheres to the principles that underpin the appointments process including the principles of appointment on merit and equality of opportunity. The Department's Public Appointments Officer is the central point of contact for CPANI and the Central Appointments Unit and disseminates information and provides advice to its sponsor branches responsible for carrying out public appointments competitions. During the appointment process sponsor branches seek to identify a wide field of candidates through public advertisement in the local and agricultural press and by placing the advertisement and candidate information pack on the Department's and NI Direct websites. Sponsor branches also write to a range of organisations and individuals, including those that have potential to identify suitable candidates from under-represented groups.

The Department is committed to increase the number of women on its public bodies and to improve diversity generally. Sponsor Branches continue to review their procedures for making appointments, with the aim of encouraging more women and other under-represented groups to apply for positions on the boards of their public bodies. This review includes the scope to adjust selection criteria to widen the pool of potential applicants for appointment competitions.

From 9 May 2016, the number of NI departments was reduced and some of the old departments will no longer exist. Therefore, responsibility for running public appointment competitions for Council for Nature Conservation and the Countryside (CNCC) which was formerly with the Department of the Environment (DOE) will fall to the new Department for Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs (DAERA).

Likewise, DAERA will no longer have responsibility for the Drainage Council for Northern Ireland (DC) as this will transfer to the Department for Infrastructure (Dfl).

2. Action

LMC: One member was reappointed to the LMC Board for a second term of office in 2016/17. Four new board members and a new Chair were appointed to LMC by open competition in 2015.

Retention of the re-appointed Board Member's knowledge and experience was considered

important to ensure continuity of experience and retention of skills within the Board, particularly in the aftermath of the destruction of the LMC office premises at Lissue House.

AWB: The Chair of the Agricultural Wages Board (AWB) was reappointed for a further three year term, with effect 1 June 2017.

AFBI: The Chair of the Agri-Food and Biosciences Institute (AFBI) was reappointed for a further term of one year, with effect from 1 April 2017. In addition, the final term of office for the Deputy Chair was extended to 31 December 2017, with effect from 1 April 2017.

CNCC: Due to the current political situation the Chair's term was extended by six months (1/3/17 to 31/8/17).

NIFHA: The NIFHA chairperson was re-appointed for a 2nd four year term from June 2016. In May 2016, three members were re-appointed for a 2nd term. Two members were newly appointed by open competition to the Board in December 2015. Prior to the open competition in 2015, meetings were arranged with potential applicants to present information about the competition.

TBSPG: The TBSPG published a Bovine Tuberculosis Eradication Strategy for Northern Ireland in December 2016.

3. Future Plans

LMC: In 2018/19, re-appointments will be considered for four members of the LMC Board and the Chair.

AFBI: During 2017/18, it is intended to appoint a new Deputy Chairperson from the existing Board membership, with the subsequent Board Member vacancy filled through use of the Reserve List established following the previous open competition to appoint Members. In addition, the department intends to initiate a competition to replace the current Chair whose final term of office will end at 31 March 2018. Three members are due to complete their first term of office at 31 March 2018 and the department will give consideration to recruitment / re-appointment in early 2017/18.

CNCC: The Department intends to hold a competition in late 2017 or early 2018. Three members of the Council are coming to the end of their 2nd term. In addition the Council's numbers are greatly reduced from that needed for optimum effectiveness.

NIFHA: Currently in the process of running an open competition to appoint one new board member from December 2017. The NIFHA will adhere to the guidance in the Code of Practice for Public Appointments and will implement initiatives, where appropriate, under the Strategic Action Plan 2016 - 2021.

Department of Education

1. Policy

The Department of Education (DE) makes appointments to a wide range of public and other bodies serving the education sector ranging from Non Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs) to school Boards of Governors.

The majority of DE public appointments are made by the Minister for Education. The main exception is appointments the Department makes to the Exceptional Circumstances Body; these are not made by the Minister.

The Department remains committed to the application of public appointment policy and in particular the overarching principle of selection on merit.

Most of the appointments the Department makes to the Boards of the non-departmental public bodies it sponsors, are regulated by the Commissioner for Public Appointments for NI (CPA NI) and the Department seeks to comply with the provisions of the Commissioner's Code of Practice when making these appointments.

The Department has a nominated official who is responsible for:

- disseminating information on policy, procedures and the Commissioner's Code of Practice;
- providing advice and guidance on appointment issues; and
- liaising with the Commissioner's Office and other Government Departments.

2. Activity

In the period from 1 April 2016 to 31 March 2017, the Department made a total of 50 appointments, re-appointments and extensions.

The Department appointed, re-appointed or extended:

- 19 school Governors;
- 8 political members of the Education Authority;
- the Chairperson and 9 members of the Council for the Curriculum, Examinations and Assessment;
- 2 members of Comhairle Na Gaelscolaíochta;
- 5 members of the Diocesan Education Committees of the Council for Catholic Maintained School;
 and
- The Chairperson and 5 members of the Youth Council for Northern Ireland.

The department is also a member of the cross departmental Public Appointments Forum which meets on a regular basis.

3. Future Plans

In the period from 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018, the Department expects to commence an appointment process seeking candidates for appointment to the Board of the Youth Council for Northern Ireland.

The reconstitution of the Boards of Governors of a number of voluntary grammar schools and grant maintained integrated schools are also due to be progressed during 2017/18. This will necessitate the appointment or re-appointment of a number of school governors.

Other appointments might need to be made during the course of the year depending on circumstances.

The Department will continue to advertise its public appointment opportunities widely - in the press; in All Aboard (the six monthly public appointment vacancy bulletins published by the Executive Office); on NI Direct and departmental websites; and directly to interested parties and stakeholders – for the purposes of attracting the widest possible pool of applicants and encouraging diversity.

1. Policy

The Department for Communities is responsible for making public appointments to a range of public bodies, as detailed in the following tables, on approval of the Minister.

When engaging with the public appointment process, the Department considers equality of opportunity, probity and proportionality. The Department ensures that all individuals appointed are committed to the principles of public life and values of public service.

2. Activity

The Department has established a Public Appointments Unit which has ownership and responsibility for public appointment related activities. It is aware of its responsibilities as detailed within the CPA NI Code of Practice, including in relation to diversity and equal opportunities.

To encourage diversity in its public appointments, and to work towards the diversity targets introduced by the NI Executive, the Department aims to attract as wide a field as possible through, for example, the advertisement of appointments, use of the "All Aboard" publication and by contacting Section 75 groups.

The Department is also keen to review and improve other key issues that underpin the wider public appointments process

3. Future Plans

Forthcoming public appointment vacancies to the Department's bodies will continue to be listed in the six-monthly list of public appointments that is published in 'All Aboard', as well as advertised in newspapers and relevant websites.

During 2017/18 a number of appointment competitions will be initiated and/or completed including for the following posts:

Departmental Public Appointment Plans and Statistics:

Department for the Economy

1. Policy

The Department for the Economy was created on 8 May 2016, following amalgamation of the majority of functions and responsibilities of the Departments for Enterprise, Trade and Investment, and Employment and Learning. DfE now has responsibility for making appointments to a wide range of NDPBs.

DfE's procedures for making appointments are designed to comply with the CPANI Code of Practice and to follow CAU guidance.

In addition to publicising public appointment vacancies in the three main newspapers, an email shot is sent out to a large and diverse range of under-represented groups and organisations for dissemination to their membership and posting to their websites. The Department also promote our public appointment opportunities on the 'All Aboard' Bulletin (published by the Central Appointments Unit), NI Direct, DfE's website and the website of the relevant NDPB, as well as social media such as Twitter and Facebook.

DfE is committed to improving its public appointments policies and processes by acting upon the recommendations and best practice guidance which emanate from the CPANI audit reports. To ensure consistency of approach, there is a dedicated Public Appointments Unit (PAU) which works closely with the DfE Sponsor Branches.

During 2016/17, DfE ran open competitions for a new Deputy Chair of the Consumer Council NI and for a new Health and Safety Executive for Northern Ireland Chair; and made an appointment, using the reserve list, to the North West Regional College. Reappointments were made to the Construction Industry Training Board; Health and Safety Executive NI; Northern Ireland Screen Commission; Stranmillis University College; and Tourism Northern Ireland.

DfE PAU staff continue to take part in diversity related initiatives including participating in the CPANI-led workshops, sitting on the DfE Diversity Group and attending the cross-departmental Public Appointment Forum (PAF).

2. Activity

DfE PAU ensured flyers were available at a 'Launch of Women's Entrepreneurship' event in Parliament Buildings and the Women in Business 8th Annual Conference, where PAU also provided input to the DfE Minister's speech at this event. DfE also continues to employ the Guaranteed Interview Scheme.

DfE used new ways to publicise public appointments and our vacancies such as, Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn; and an article in the Belfast Telegraph's "How I became a..."

3. Future Plans

In 2017 DfE intends to run open competitions to the Boards of:

- Construction Industry Training Board
- Consumer Council NI
- Further Education Colleges
- Invest NI
- Labour Relations Agency
- Northern Ireland Screen
- Office of the Industrial Tribunal & Fair Employment Tribunal
- Stranmillis University College

DfE will continue to review and revise procedures and documentation for competitions, including exploring online technologies. This will, hopefully, encourage people from diverse backgrounds and non-traditional career paths to apply, achieving the best possible spread of applicants and, ultimately, appointees.

DfE have produced a new suite of flyers to encourage future audiences to want to know more about public appointments. These concepts can be tailored and will change from appointment to appointment, depending on the body and the target audience.

DfE will facilitate mentoring schemes such as the QUB Graduate School Mentoring Programme (there are three bodies willing to participate in this scheme) and Chairs of two of DfE bodies have agreed in principle to participate in The Boardroom Apprentice programme.

Department for Infrastructure

1. Policy

The Department's Minister makes appointments to six public bodies as follows:

- Northern Ireland Water Limited
- Northern Ireland Transport Holding Company
- Belfast Harbour Commissioners
- ➤ Londonderry Port and Harbour Commissioners
- Warrenpoint Harbour Authority
- Drainage Council Northern Ireland

The Department is committed to complying with the provisions of the Commissioner for Public Appointments for Northern Ireland (CPA NI) Code of Practice for Ministerial Appointments and regularly reviews CPANI Audit Reports to identify best practice approaches.

Going forward the Department will strive to work towards the targets agreed by the Executive for gender equality, subject to the overriding principle of selection based on merit.

All public appointment vacancies are advertised to ensure as wide a pool of applicants as possible. Advertisements appear in all the main local papers, appropriate trade publications, NI Direct and the Department's website and Twitter accounts.

In an effort to increase the diversity of Boards, a wide range of groups, including groups which are representative of women, people with disabilities and ethnic minorities, are notified of planned competitions and advertisements and encouraged to disseminate the information across their networks.

The Department continues to operate a central Public Appointments Unit to manage all aspects of the public appointments process in consultation with four Sponsor Divisions. The Public Appointments Unit runs all of the Department's appointment competitions in line with best practice to ensure greater consistency and compliance with the CPA NI Code.

2. Activity

The Dfl Minister appointed two non-executive members to Warrenpoint Harbour Authority effective from 1 November 2016

Dfl continues to be represented on the NICS Public Appointments Forum which helps develop policy and the sharing of best practice across the NICS in public appointments.

DfI has taken a range of measures to make public appointment competitions more accessible and attractive to women, younger people, people with disabilities and ethnic minorities. The competition launched in 16/17 was notified in advance to around 400 groups by targeted email. Measures also include making all reappointments subject to open public competition. The Department has continued to use a menu approach for the selection criterion for competitions to try to encourage a greater range of applicants from a variety of diverse and non-traditional backgrounds.

In each competition, the Department uses a Guaranteed Interview Scheme for disabled applicants.

The Department follows best practice drawing on the NICS Common Guidance – Principles and Practice developed by the Public Appointments Forum and the CPA NI Code of Practice.

The Department continues to use an Independent Assessor provided by CPANI for each selection panel for each of the DfI public appointments competitions.

3. Future Plans

The Department plans to launch and complete the following competitions throughout 2017/2018

- Londonderry Port and Harbour Commissioners Chair appointment- effective 8 February 2017; and
- Belfast Harbour Commissioners one Councillor appointment.

Members of the Public Appointments Unit will promote best practice in public appointments in association with the Public Appointments Forum and CPANI advice and guidance.

The Department monitors progress closely in terms of diversity of applicants; and to continuously improve the appointment process and increase awareness of public appointments opportunities.

The Department will play an active role in the NICS Public Appointments Diversity 5 – year Strategic

Action plan.

Departmental Public Appointment Plans and Statistics:

Department of Finance

1. Policy

Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (The Utility Regulator)

The Utility Regulator is a non-ministerial government department established by the Energy (Northern Ireland) Order 2003, amended by the Water and Sewerage Services (Northern Ireland) Order 2006. It is responsible for regulating the electricity and gas industries and water and sewerage services in Northern Ireland, to promote the short and long-term interests of consumers.

Members of the Board of the Utility Regulator are appointed by the Finance Minister. The Board consists of a Chairperson and at least 3 other members. The terms of appointment of the Chairman and other members are determined by the Minister.

Statistics Advisory Committee (SAC)

SAC is a statutory committee which provides advice to NI Departments on matters relating to the collection and disclosure of statistical information under the Statistics of Trade and Employment (Northern Ireland) Order 1988. It also advises on such matters as may be referred to it by Departments.

Northern Ireland Building Regulations Advisory Committee (NIBRAC)

NIBRAC is a statutory committee established by Article 4 of the Building Regulations (NI) Order 1979 (as amended). Its function is to advise the Department on amendments to building regulations or other connected matters that the Department may bring to it. The Minister appoints members to the Committee. The Department seeks to ensure that the Committee represents a broad spectrum of construction related skills and gender diversity. There are currently no members on the NIBRAC.

2. Activity

Northern Ireland Authority for Utility Regulation (The Utility Regulator)

The Utility Regulator Board and its sub committees continued to meet on a regular basis throughout the year.

Statistics Advisory Committee (SAC)

During 2016/17 the Statistics Advisory Committee continued to meet regularly (three formal meetings were convened). In addition, work was also taken forward by correspondence as necessary.

Northern Ireland Building Regulations Advisory Committee (NIBRAC)

No NIBRAC Committee meetings took place during 2016/17, as meetings are driven by the work programme and upcoming changes to Building Regulations. However prior to September 2016, the committee provided input on proposals for relatively minor amendments to the Building Regulations by email correspondence.

3. Future Plans

NIBRAC

It is hoped to run a competition to appoint new Board members and a Chair during 2017/18.

The Legal Services Oversight Commissioner (LSOC)

The Legal Services Oversight Commissioner is a statutory position established by the Legal Complaints and Regulation Act (Northern Ireland) 2016. The Commissioner is an independent officer responsible for making provisions regarding complaints against members of the legal profession in Northern Ireland. The Act introduced new provisions which will lead to a move away from a system where legal professionals handle their own complaints process, to one where lay people lead the process. The new Commissioner has an important role in overseeing the introduction of this new system and monitoring the effectiveness of these new structures.

A competition to fill the post of Legal Services Oversight Commissioner took place in 2016/17 and the successful candidate was appointed on 3rd April 2017.

Departmental Public Appointment Plans and Statistics:

Department of Health

1. Policy

The Department of Health (DoH) makes appointments to a wide range of public and other health related bodies. The Department is committed to following the Code of Practice issued by the Commissioner for Public Appointments for Northern Ireland.

The Department's Appointments Unit has responsibility for managing the procedures which reflect this Code of Practice. The Unit provides advice and guidance on appointment issues to organisations and individuals and consults and liaises with the Office of the Commissioner for Public Appointments. Staff in the Unit manage the entire process from advertising, facilitating the short-listing and interview panels and drafting the initial and final submissions to the Minister, requesting ACCESS NI checks and notifying the outcome of the competition to all applicants. Appointments Unit is also responsible for co-ordinating action on queries, challenges and complaints and represents the Department on the cross departmental Public Appointments forum which meets quarterly.

All Departmental public appointments are the responsibility of the Minister who at the outset of each competition approves the Role Profile, Person Specification, Length of Appointment and Appointment Plan.

An Independent Assessor allocated by the Office of the Commissioner for Public Appointments Northern Ireland is a member of all short listing and interview panels alongside a Senior Civil Servant and a third panel member who has expertise either in the work of the organisation or within that field of expertise.

The Department is committed to the principle of selection on merit and to improving diversity on the boards of the public and other bodies for which it has responsibility.

2. Activity

As at 31 March 2017, the Department was responsible for 160 public appointments across 18 Health & Social Care (HSC) bodies, all of which are regulated appointments. In addition the Department is responsible for a further 26 appointments across 3 bodies which are unregulated.

Appointments Unit has developed a competition timetable in order to ensure that all positions are filled as soon as practically possible. During the year 1 April 2016 to 31 March 2017, DOH made a total of 25 initial/first term appointments and 3 re-appointments. In addition, 29 extensions to appointments were made.

Appointments Unit liaised with both the Departmental business areas and the Chair of the relevant organisation at the outset of the competition to identify any potential 'skills gaps' and to agree the Role Profiles, Person Specifications and selection criteria. The Unit has ensured that all panel members have had the appropriate training as required by the Commissioner for Public Appointments Northern Ireland.

In order to promote and improve Diversity the Department has taken the following actions to ensure that the widest pool of individuals were aware of the Department's appointment opportunities:

 Appointments Unit has bench-marked with other Government Departments to identify additional actions to increase diversity in its public appointments.

- Advertisements were placed in the three Regional newspapers, on the Department's
 website, on social media and with relevant organisations/individuals e.g. if appointing
 a locally elected representative member, each elected representative and Council
 receives notification.
- The Department has developed a Public Appointments mailing list and has taken steps to encourage both individuals and organisations to be included.
- Forthcoming vacancies were listed in the 'All Aboard' Bulletin issued by Central Appointments.
- A "Welcome Statement" on all our advertisements for appointment to Health and Social Care bodies has stated that we welcome applicants from all Section 75 categories.
- The Department has added an additional number of umbrella organisations to our mailing list including additional organisations representing those groups currently under represented on DHSSPS public bodies
- A concerted effort has been made to target groups representing women in addition to groups representing people from an ethnic minority background and those representing people with disabilities.

The composition of members of our public bodies at 31 March 2017 was 61 female (41%) and 89 male (59%).

3. Future Plans

Increasing diversity remains a key challenge for the Department in the 2017/2018 year. We will continue to liaise with the Office of the Commissioner for Public Appointments and with other Government Departments to identify best practice and ensure that all possible positive action is taken. The Department will continue to seek out and avail of opportunities to raise awareness and engage with groups and the wider public.

DoH will expand and develop the knowledge of staff working in public appointments and work with sponsor branches in the Department to ensure the best service possible is delivered.

Following restructuring of Government Departments in May 2016 the Department will be known as the Department of Health however there will be no change in its responsibilities for public appointments.

Department of Justice

1. Policy

The Minister of Justice has responsibility for approval of all DoJ public appointments, including approving the role and person specifications, the appointment timetable, the selection method and the final selection of successful candidates from those deemed suitable for appointment.

DoJ is committed to the principle of selection on merit, and complies with the Code of Practice for Ministerial Public Appointments published by the Commissioner for Public Appointments NI, when making appointments to public bodies within the Commissioner's remit. We are also committed to having due regard to the Commissioner's Code of Practice when making appointments to public bodies that fall outside the Commissioner's remit.

Committed to Improving diversity on the boards of public bodies, we actively aim to attract applications from a broad range of candidates. Through our membership of TEO's Public Appointments Forum we contribute to the Public Appointments Diversity 5-year Strategic Action Plan (2016-21). The Action Plan identifies a number of sub-groups to take forward specific actions. A representative from DoJ chairs TEO's Appointment Process Review Sub-group.
