Health and Social Care Northern Ireland Quarterly Workforce Bulletin September 2020

Key Findings

- The Health and Social Care Northern Ireland Workforce, at 30th September 2020, stood at 70,389 (61,553.0 whole-time equivalent [WTE]). This figure excludes staff on career breaks, bank staff and Home Helps, due to the variable nature of their contracted hours, members of staff with a WTE of less than 0.03, Chairs/Members of Boards and Out of Hours GPs.
- The largest single staff group was Qualified Nursing & Midwifery, with 15,834 WTE. This represented an increase of 548 WTE (or 3.6%) from the previous September.
- Between September 2016 and September 2020, there was a net increase of ~1,577 WTE (20.8%) in the Professional & Technical staff group. This group includes the Allied Health Professions and support staff (e.g. physiotherapists, radiotherapists, dieticians and podiatrists) along with Scientific & Technical staff (e.g. laboratory staff).
- The Medical & Dental workforce increased by 706 WTE (17.7%) between September 2016 and September 2020. The annual increase from September 2019 was 230 WTE (5.1%).

The recorded whole-time equivalent for home helps does not adequately reflect the full contribution of these staff, due to the variable hours of contracts. Home Helps are therefore excluded from this analysis.

This symbol is used in order to minimise the risk of personal disclosure, where it may be possible to identify an individual from the data provided. As a result of this protocol overall totals are correct although some row and column sub-totals may have been changed; the cells affected have been marked with a tilde (-). This will not affect the accuracy of overall staff totals but may mean that some individual columns or rows do not sum.
