

## **MANAGEMENT NOTES:**

Week Beginning 15 October 2018

- Warm conditions last week have caused a rise in soil temperatures and supported good growth conditions on farm across Northern Ireland with growth rates still achieving over 30kg DM/ha on farm. Growth is expected to decline but with warm temperature expected to prevail, there is still opportunity to grow an addition 0.25t DM/ha before the end of the month. Grass quality also remains strong for this time of year with CP and ME contents.
- With the high levels of rainfall over the weekend soil moisture levels have rising significantly on heavy soils. Consider on-off grazing and move dry stock daily to avoid poaching damage in wetter fields.
