








MANAGEMENT NOTES:

- Grass growth is forecast to remain above the LT av. over the next two weeks, with soil moisture levels and heat providing ideal growing conditions.
- Grazing covers can change massively over a short period, increasing the importance of measuring every 5 days and grazing swards at 2900 Kg DM/ha.
- Identify and remove surplus grass/high covers quickly, by increasing the grazing demand (increasing stock numbers or reducing supplement feed) or reducing the grazing area (removing surplus grass as baled silage).
- Predicted performance from grass has reduced, due to a drop in ME (MJ/kg DM). Target removing surplus bales from areas that have had poorer post grazing residuals to maintain grass quality through the peak growth stage.
