









Week Beginning 5th September 2022





- The start of September has seen all areas receiving some welcome rainfall.
- Grass growth is predicted to return to close to the LT av. over the next fortnight, due to the mild showery weather conditions set to continue.
- Building grass covers for the Autumn may seem like wishful thinking for many. Maintain av. farm cover above a min of 2,000 kg DM/ha and continue with low grass demand and maintain/extend rotation length to 30+ days.
- Carry out a fodder budget ahead of the winter period, especially those who have had to feed significant amounts of fodder over the summer period.
- If fodder supplies are in short supply, act sooner rather than later to secure additional forage or reduce your demand to avoid shocks and stress later on.
