




- Following a dry and settled spell, we see a return to unsettled conditions.
- Grass growth rates are predicted to rise over the next 7 days to 46.2 kg DM/ha, in line with the 10-year average.
- Prioritise maintaining grass in the animal's diet and turning out any additional stock that are suitable to graze, in order to establish a grazing wedge before grass growth rates and the average farm cover (AFC) increases.
- In the first rotation the AFC should not drop below 2,150 Kg DM/ha.

• Use your weekly grass measurement figures, together with your herd demand to prepare a feed budget and conserve silage where possible. Assess silage stocks and prepare a plan for the amount and area of silage required.
