

### **TRUST BOARD PERFORMANCE REPORT – MAY 2022**

Prepared and issued by Performance and Information Services

7 July 2022

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#### Context

This report sets out the May 2022 performance position on key services areas. During this month, services performed well across the majority of areas against pre-pandemic levels. The currently attained level of delivery is summarised on Pages 5-7 of the report.

Following publication in June 2020 of the Strategic Framework for Rebuilding HSC Services by the Minister for Health, Trusts have been developing quarterly rebuild/service delivery plans for publication by the DoH setting out plans to incrementally increase service delivery across a range of areas. These have been supported by an activity annex detailing the planned activity for each quarter and delivery has been monitored on a monthly basis both internally within the Trust and regionally by the SPPG. The most recent quarterly plan covers the period 1 April 2022 to 30 June 2022.

At the Rebuilding Management Board (RMB) meeting of 8 June 2022, it was agreed that the primary focus for HSC for 2022/23 was to secure a return to pre-Covid-19 (2019/20) activity levels by the end of September 2022 or as soon as possible thereafter.

To support this, a HSC Service Delivery Plan covering the remaining 9 months of the year (1 July 2022 to 31 March 2023) has been drafted by SPPG (DoH) which includes the proposed performance trajectories required to bring service provision back to pre-Covid-19 levels. The Trust received the first version of the proposed trajectories on the 13<sup>th</sup> June and an updated version on the 20<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

During June intense work commenced with service leads to assess the achievability of these performance trajectories which had been set by SPPG, and any challenges or barriers that would impact on deliverability.

As reported previously, there are already a significant number of our services that are achieving or close to returning to pre-pandemic levels of activity and all services will continue to work to maintain and improve on this. It must also be recognised however that challenges are likely to remain for the rest of 2022/23 with increasing COVID-19 transmission rates, the extent of winter surge and workforce impacts.

The Trust will continue to focus internally on maximising delivery, and will work with SPPG to understand any deviation from trajectories as and if it occurs.

#### Phase 9 Plan – May 2022 Position

During May 2022, the primary area where we have seen deviation from the Phase 9 plan are in 14 Day and 62 Day Cancer Services, Adult Mental Health new assessments, and domiciliary care delivery. These services all continue to experience ongoing challenges to service delivery, which are primarily workforce based.

During May 2022, of the 108 patients treated, 99% received their first definitive treatment within 31 days of a decision to treat and 1 patient waited over 31 days, the longest wait was 35 days for a Head & Neck tumour site patient.

#### 62 Day Pathway

During May 2022, of the 64 patients treated, 50% received their first definitive treatment within 62 days of referral and 32 (35 patients, 6 ITT pts) waited over 62 days. The longest wait was 217 days for a Lower GI patient.

Performance against the 62 Day Cancer target (50% compliance with the pathway), is below 2019/20 level (60-62%) and has largely remained at this level over recent months. Whilst every effort is being made to rebuild services there are a number of challenges which are impacting on delivery. The number of red flag referrals received for all suspect cancer tumour sites during May 2022 was 28% greater than that in May 2019. The increase in red flag referrals is seen across a number of sub-specialties in particular Urology, Upper GI, Gynae, Skin and Lower GI. The number of suspect cancer patients being tracked has increased, and access to theatre sessions and timely access to diagnostic services remains challenging.

Performance against the 4 hour standard has steadily dropped in Altnagelvin over the last number of months and improved in SWAH. To improve hospital flow, work is progressing to focus on increasing discharges and reducing length of stay as part of the rebuild targets set by SPPG. Director-led Flow meetings have continued in Altnagelvin hospital to maintain focus on this area of care.

#### **Community Services**

During May 2022, Community Services have delivered across most areas against predicted Phase 9 plans. Day Care remains the main area of rebuild challenge against pre-pandeic levels, and work is ongoing to ensure service users who wish to return to Day Care/Day Opportunities are facilitated, in a risk managed way.

#### **Day Care Services**

Overall, the Trust has delivered 19,006 day care attendances between April 2022 and May 2022, against a rebuild target of 19,066 attendances (99%), compared to 26,912 attendances for the same period in 2019/20 (71%). Further detail by service area is provided in the table below.

All areas have been updating dynamic risk assessments and been considering and adopting new ways of working to maximise capacity for those attending. Every effort continues to be made to mitigate the impact of IPC measures in order to return to pre-Covid levels.

#### **COVID-19 Update**

Since the last report to Trust Board in May 2022 the number of COVID-19 positive inpatients in our hospitals has increased slightly from 51 to 54 at the 28<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

There is an indication of growing levels of transmission in the community. The Trust has continued to maintain Covid-19 pathways in both scheduled and unscheduled care in our hospitals which remains under review as the Trust completes dynamic risk assessments for its services.







## **Unscheduled Care** 12 hour performance










#### **Complex Discharges % within 48 Hours**







### **Complex Discharges > 7 Days**






