1 Key documents

The <u>Windsor Framework: A New Way Forward</u> was agreed in principle on 27 February 2023. It seeks to amend the Ireland/Northern Ireland Protocol in order to 'uphold Northern Ireland's integral place in the United Kingdom, address the democratic deficit and set out a new way forward'.

Opposition to the Protocol concerning trade and sovereignty issues led the UK Government to introduce the Northern Ireland Protocol Bill in June 2022. Following publication of the Framework Agreement, the UK Government has stated a legal position paper (February 2023) that the Northern Ireland Protocol Bill will no longer be needed.
