## **Key trends**

In the w/e 16/04/23 the average R3 heifer price in the EU was 522.3/kg, up 0.6c/kg from the w/e 19/03/23.

NI climbed three places to second place on the EU league table with an equivalent price of 555.4c/kg. This was up 8.5c/kg from the w/e 19/03/23. In the w/e 19/03/23 the R3 heifer price in NI was 25.1c/kg above the EU average and 33.1c/kg above the EU average price in the w/e 16/04/23.



GB placed top position on the EU league table in the w/e 16/04/23. The equivalent R3 heifer price was 560.7c/kg up 3.3c/kg from the w/e 19/03/23. GB was 35.7c/kg ahead of the EU average in the w/e 19/03/23 and 38.4c/kg ahead of the EU average price in the w/e 16/04/23.



In ROI the R3 heifer price was 531.6c/kg in the w/e 16/04/23, which is a 2.7c/kg increase from the w/e 19/03/23. ROI remained in sixth place on the EU league table in the week ending 16/04/23. ROI was 9.3c/kg above the EU average price and 23.8c/kg behind the same price in NI in the w/e 16/04/23.

The euro rate increased to €1= 88.1p in the w/e 16/04/23.
