No police link to death but officers disciplined over pursuit through village

Two police officers have been disciplined after driving at 81mph through a 30mph zone in the village of Claudy in an unmarked police vehicle with no sirens or flashing lights activated. It follows a Police Ombudsman investigation into the incident, which took place on Sunday 11 December 2011. A car which police had been following crashed, killing a woman passenger.

Wearing of mask was not insensitive



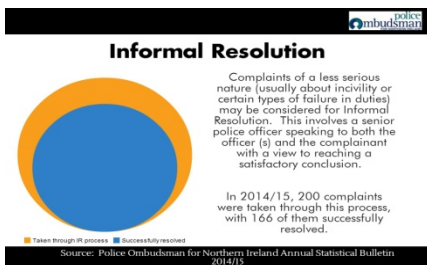

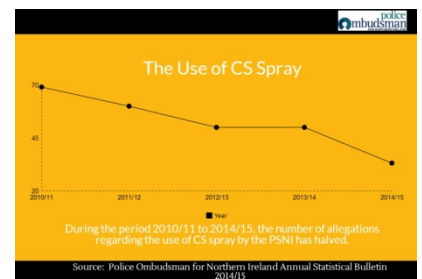
