Welcome to the thirtieth edition of 'All Aboard' the news-sheet of the Central Appointments Unit (CAU) in the Executive Office.



PURPOSE

Its purpose is twofold, to provide information about public appointments and public bodies in Northern Ireland and publicise our six monthly **forthcoming** public appointments vacancy list for public appointments arising from **1 January 2020 to 30 June 2020**.



THE LIVESTOCK & MEAT COMMISSION IS MUCH MORE THAN ITS NAME SUGGESTS



People often look at The Livestock and Meat Commission for Northern Ireland (LMC) name and automatically assume the organisation must be about farming and meat production and that you must have to know something about the industry to be a Board member of LMC. Well to an extent they are right in that LMC will seek to recruit certain of its Board member positions with specialist experience in the production and processing of beef and lamb as it is participants in this industry who provide most of LMC's funding through statutory levy and other services. LMC is a relatively small organisation compared to the overall scale of the red meat industry in Northern Ireland, which generated sales of £1.3billion in 2017.

However, the important services which LMC provide are valued by the industry and are designed to help the sector cement its position as a leading contributor to the local economy in Northern Ireland.

The activities and services which LMC provide bring the organisation into direct contact with a wide range of stakeholders including farmers, meat processors, retail and food service customers of industry, consumers of beef and lamb, school teachers and school children, agri-food industry representative bodies, research and knowledge transfer sectors, government departments, other food promotional bodies, political representatives and the media.

LMC are seeking to fill one member position. As the Board member with responsibility for Chairing the LMC Audit and Risk Assurance Committee (ARAC) you will be working alongside the LMC Chairman and 4 other Board members to direct and oversee LMC's Strategy for delivering outcomes within its specific functions that align with DAERA's strategic direction and the Programme for Government in Northern Ireland. If you have the skill sets to be the Board Member and ARAC Chair it is not essential that you have agri-food industry experience and LMC would particularly welcome an appointment that would help to enhance female representation on the Board of the Commission.
